Updated Wage Scales for Local 183 and 793 2022-2025

Attached are the updated wage scales for Locals 183 and 793 reflecting the monetary changes made in the recently ratified collective agreements, as well as an overview presentation which additionally reflects all of the language changes that were made.

In short, for the 2022 year:

For Local 183

Category	Change Over 2021
Wage	+ \$1.59
Vacation Pay	+ \$0.16
Welfare	+ \$0.15
Retiree Fund	+ \$0.10
Pension	+ \$0.20
Training	+ \$0.05
TOTAL	\$2.25

- An additional increase of \$0.50/hour is included in Schedules D & F for the classification of CCTV, Combo, Flusher.
- Schedule D Hydro Excavation Helper (Schedule A) pension rate has been increased from \$5.50 to \$10.14 and Hydro Excavation Helper (Sched C) pension rate from \$5.50 to \$8.32, to match the Hydro Excavation tradesperson pension rates.
- Per kilometer travel rate increases to \$0.65 (up from \$0.60).
- Out of town allowance rates increase to \$170 per night (up from \$140).
- 183 has also provided a new set of wage tables for Schedule H the schedule applying to our new accredited areas in Board Areas 10 (Port Hope & Coburg); 11 (Peterborough); and 12 (West of the Trent River only).



For Local 793

Wage	+ \$2.00
Vacation Pay	+ \$0.20
Benefits	- \$0.10
Pension	\$0
Training	+ \$0.05
SUB Plan	+ \$0.10
TOTAL	\$2.25

- Per kilometer travel rate to the posted CRA travel rate (currently \$0.61/km).
- Out of town allowance rates increase to \$170 per night (up from \$140).
- An increase of up to \$20/day for parking (matching Local 183).
- 793 has not included an updated wage schedule for the newly accredited areas, but it will be made available soon (it was an oversight).
